

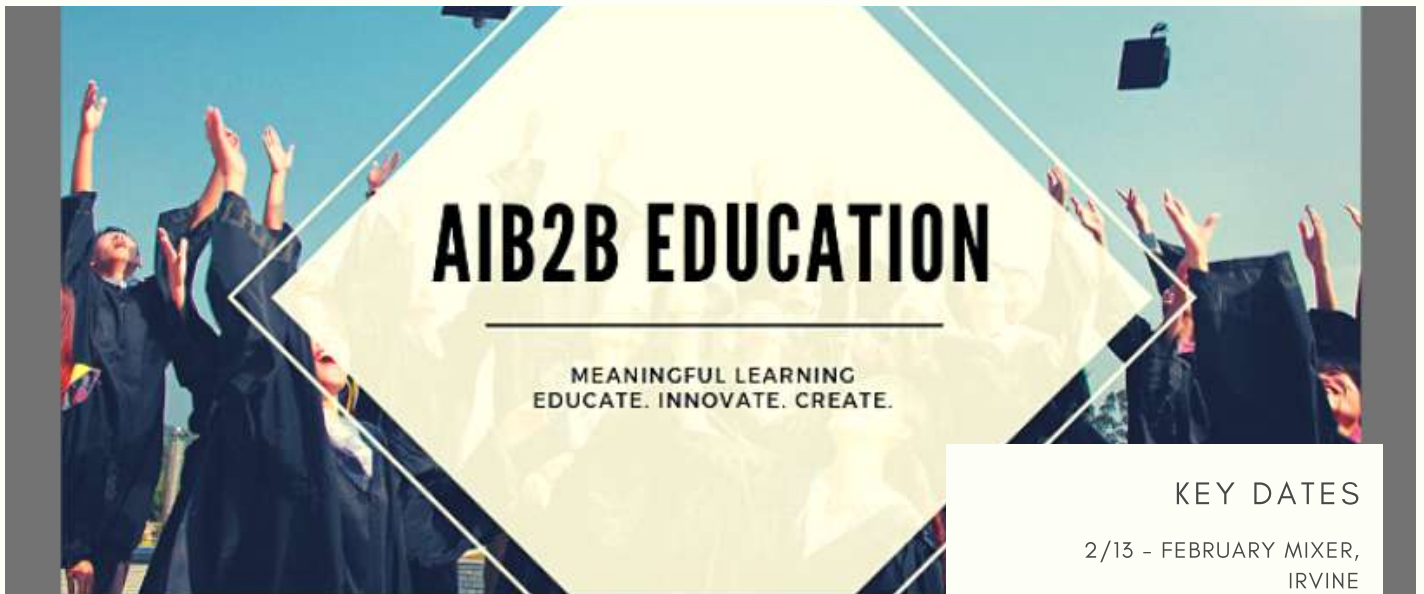

Program began with opening remarks from Sean Flynn, an AIB member and visionary for this event in San Bernardino.

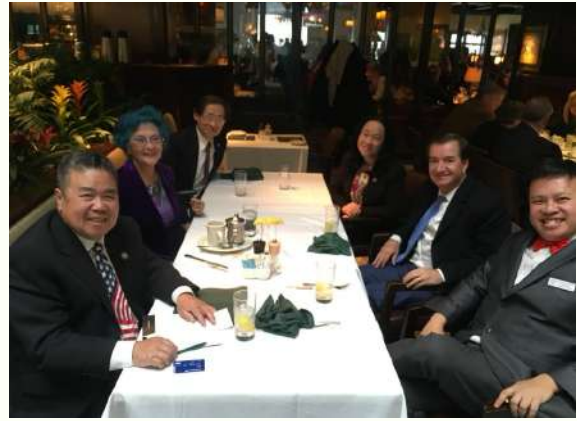

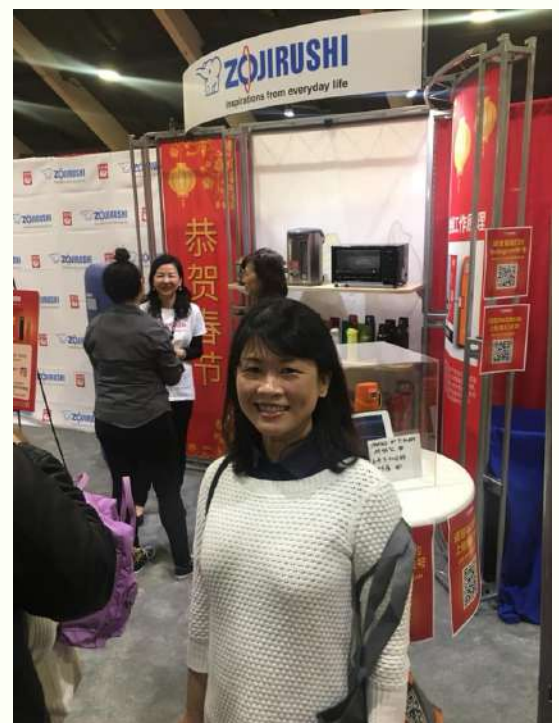
