Community panel will feature survivor of the trade Shari Ho, local nonprofits, law enforcement and other warriors for the cause.

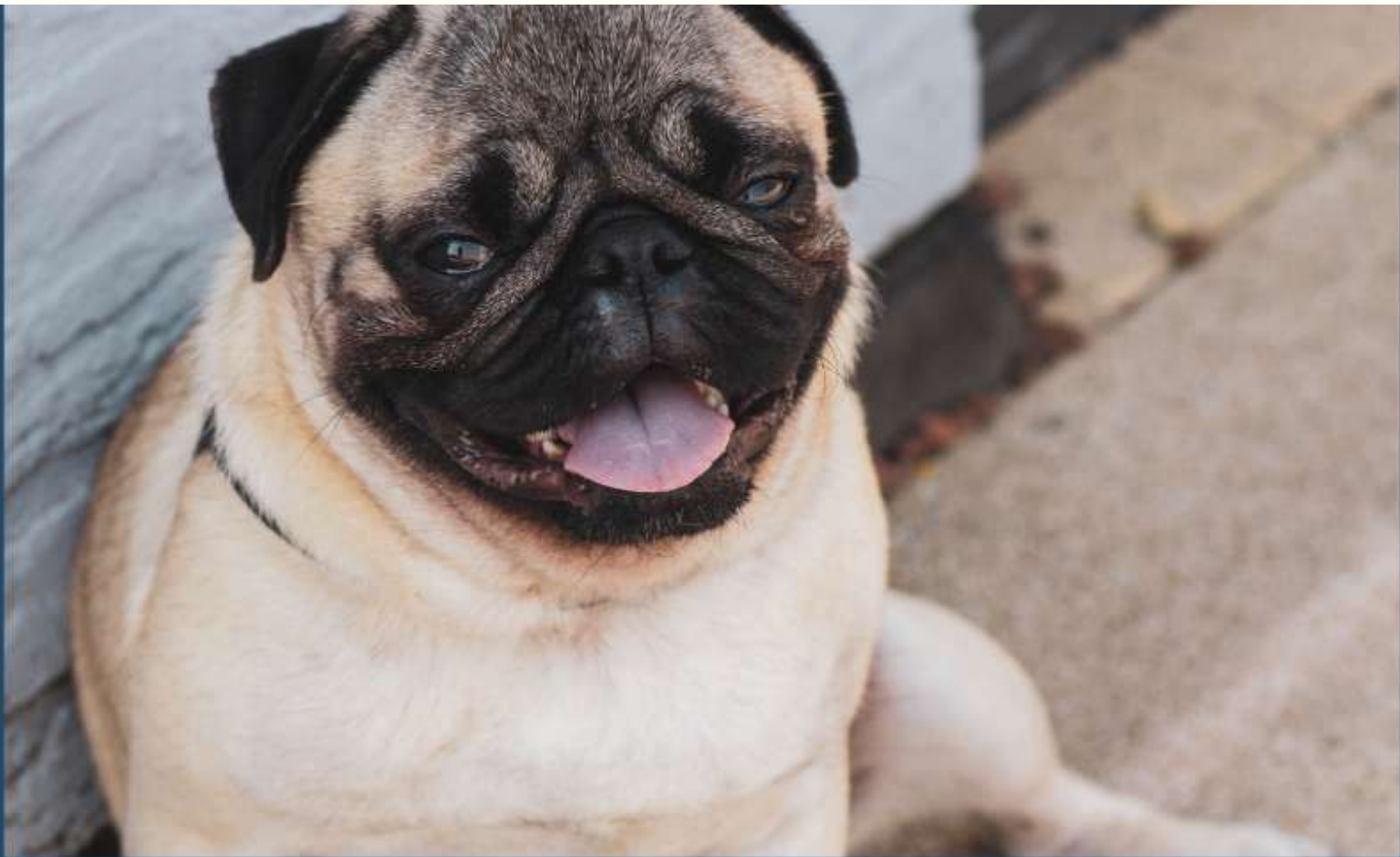

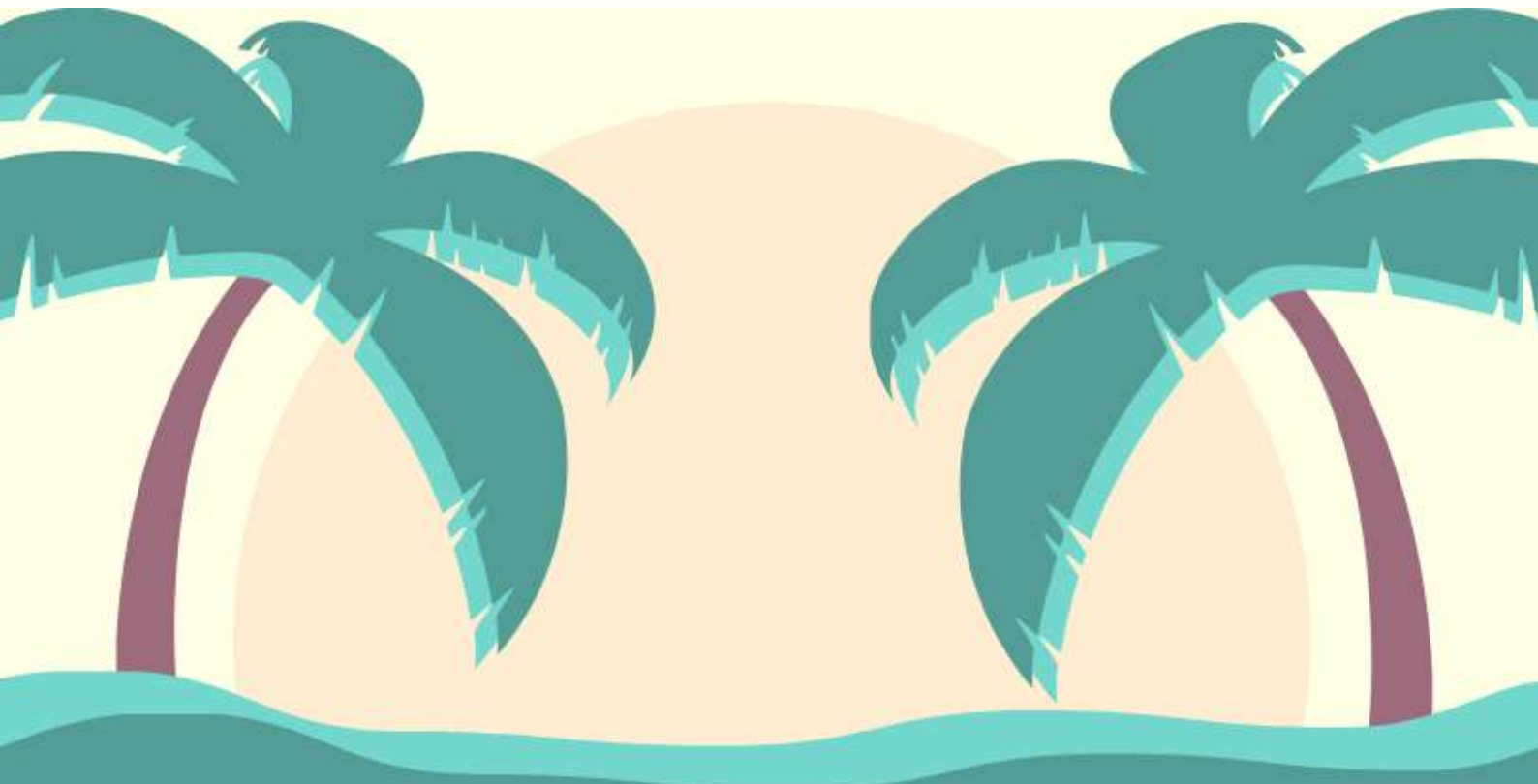
