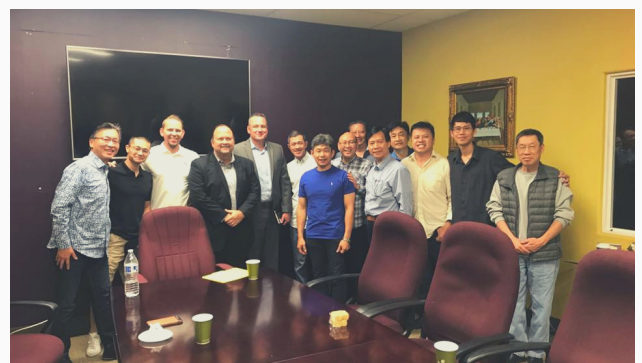

At AIB, we deeply believe in the power of non-profits to impact communities and create change. We focus largely on more localized non-profits because we believe they are the most effective and efficient in bringing help to where it is needed whether domestic or international.

This month, we had the privilege of partnering with Asian Business Association Orange County (ABAOC) to tour one of these organizations.

Free Wheelchair Mission is located in Irvine, California. They focus on providing affordable wheelchairs to the disabled in the developing world. The need is extremely dire in areas where diseases, lack of medical care, and even cultural shaming requires the disabled to crawl on the floor or live at the mercy of their communities. We have seen this even in places like Taiwan where the disabled are seen

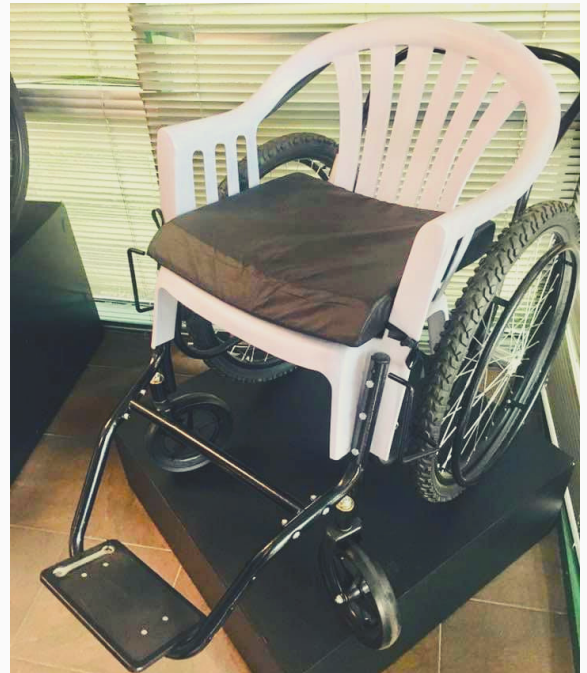
laying on the streets of the outdoor market places begging for anyone walking past to spare some food or money.

The solution to this need are affordable but effective wheelchairs. Free Wheelchair Mission does this with three different models meant for three types of terrain that are able to withstand the test of climate and day-to-day use. Each model is carefully engineered and quickly assembled using durable materials. Lastly, each apparatus is delivered throughout the world including Sudan, Iraq, China, and Laos, just to name a few.
