BREAKING THE GRASS CEILING

SAN JACINTO, CA

On September 29, AIB members toured the first licensed hemp farm in Riverside County. AIB member Andy Huang is a hemp expert and has been educating members on the benefits of CBD.

Only a few years ago, CBD was a taboo subject that the public often confused with marijuana or getting high. That is no longer the case. The Hemp Farming Act of 2018 was a proposed law to remove hemp (defined as cannabis with less than 0.3% THC) from Schedule I controlled substances and making it an ordinary agricultural commodity. Its provisions were incorporated in the 2018 United States farm bill that became law on December 20, 2018. Today CBD is used over the counter for a variety of ailments including even for pets!

The hemp farm AIB toured is a 20 acres grow operation in San Jacinto where members were able to tour and see the plants ready to be harvest shortly after the tour.

After harvesting, the hemp is processed into oils, tablets, creams, and lip balms.
