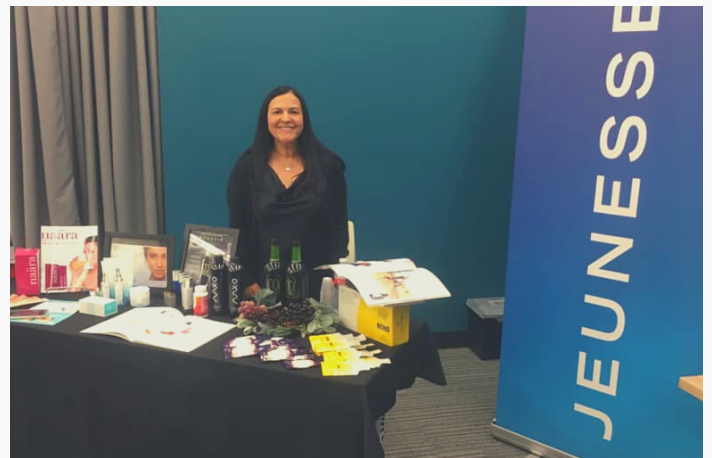


Health is Wealth
