JANET NGUYEN-ING COSTA MESA, CA

Senator Janet Nguyen represents northern Orange County. She is the first Vietnamese-American state Senator in the United States and the country's first Vietnamese-American woman state legislator. Prior to being elected to the state Senate, she was an Orange County Supervisor, representing the First District. At the age of 30, she was the youngest person to be elected to the board of supervisors, the first woman to be elected from the First District, and the first Vietnamese-American county supervisor in the United States.

Most recently in 2020, Democrat Diedre Nguyen split the vote with Tyler Diep who lost in the primary and eventually Diedre lost to Janet in the general.

THE CITY OF FOUNTAIN VALLEY ADOPTS MARINE CORPS UNIT

FOUNTAIN VALLEY, CA

In the 2000's, it became a tradition that cities around Camp Pendleton would "adopt" various Marine Corps units. The two groups would then build and maintain a relationship that would mutually support the other. Cities like Laguna Hills, Newport Beach, Laguna Niguel, and San Clemente all adopted a battalion of Marines and sailors or about 800 individuals. They would do potlucks, 5k's, and collect toys during the holidays. The Marines would also attend the Memorial Day or July 4th events.

One of the councilman in Fountain Valley, Michael Vo, reached out to AIB in hopes of creating a similar bond. As a result, the 5th Battalion 11th Marines of the 1st Marine Division was adopted by the city of Fountain Valley.

The 5th Battalion 11th Marines (5/11) is a High Mobility Artillery Rocket System battalion consisting of four Firing Batteries and a Headquarters Battery. The battalion is stationed at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California. It is the first active duty HIMARS Unit in the Marine Corps.

Have you heard of Blaise Pascal? Well, there is a funny thing about a question like this, and if you haven't found it out yet, here it is; no matter how you answer the question, you are going to hear about Blaise Pascal, or kangaroos, or who won the World Series in 19-something. Answering "No, and I don't want to know." doesn't get you anywhere either. See, the questioner wants to tell you something and the question is just a conversational gambit. So, here is what I want to tell you about Blaise Pascal.

Blaise Pascal was a French mathematician, physicist, inventor, and Catholic theologian. He was a child prodigy, writing a notable treatise on the subject of projective geometry (?!) at the age of 16. He was born 19 June 1623. He died 19 August 1662. He was 39 years old.

Blaise Pascal is well known for "Pascal's Wager", his look at the conundrum of God's existence and man's relationship or response to that question. To quote Wikipedia "It posits that human beings wager with their lives that God either exists or does not." My adaptation of his argument is as follows:

- 1. God either exits or He does not.
- 2. Man either believes in God or he does not.

From those two statements certain things follow: if God exists and Man believes in, and obeys Him, he suffers finite loss (he has to follow all those rules about virtue and refrain from taking other people's stuff) but gains infinite joy (life with God).

If God exists and Man does not believe in, and obey Him, he gains finite pleasures, which he loses when he dies and suffers infinite loss (eternity without God)

If God does not exist, but Man believes that he does, Man will lose the finite pleasures already mentioned, but he will gain the other finite pleasures of an ordered, virtuous, happy life. He will die not knowing anything else.

If God does not exist and Man believes that He does not exist, he will have some finite pleasures, but they will be tainted with the despair that comes from a life that came into being without purpose and that ends in nothingness. I think this holds true for "Mental Health – The Spirit".

The materialistic view of life posits that we are simply matter, brought into existence by chance, moving through life by chance, exiting this world by chance. But numerous studies have shown that people who embrace this view have higher rates of mental disorders, depression, and stress.

So, like Pascal's Wager about the existence of God, I propose that we bet on happiness, bet on the spirit, bet on the immortality in each of us. That each of us is more than a bunch of molecules moving through space, coming from nowhere, going nowhere.
